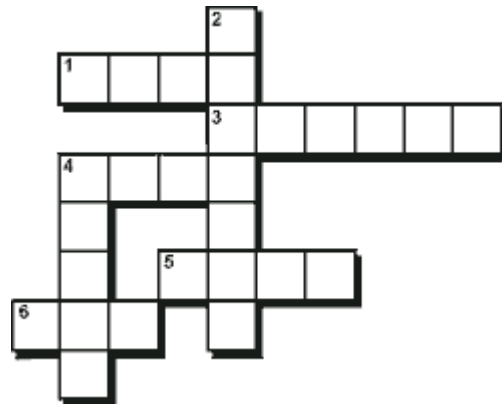
The Destruction of Sodom and Gomorrah
